6. Workshop- Thursday, January 16, 2020

A. Proposed adoption of language to NAC 638: The proposed language will change the definitions of intern/extern to more accurately reflect their use and scope of practice as well as add language to allow for temporary licensure for veterinarians in the State of Nevada.

Intern/Extern/Veterinary Graduate Awaiting Licensure & Temporary Licensure

<u>Dr. Pelsue</u>- gave brief overview of current proposed language for VGAL (Veterinary Graduate Awaiting Licensure) and temporary licensure.

Dr. Gorman- Do we also need to include a definition of Veterinary Intern?

Louis Ling- Yes, we will also have a definition of Intern, Extern, and a VGAL.

<u>Dr. Sandoval</u>- With Temporary licensure can the 2 10-day periods be consecutive?

Pelsue- Yes, a maximum of 20 days in a 12-month period.

Veterinary Nursing Initiative

<u>Ling</u>- The reg has been rejected by LCB due to language in the Nursing Board regs. Statute in Nursing regs that states you may only use the term "nurse" if you are licensed by the nursing Board.

<u>Pedigo</u>- the most effective way may if NAVTA runs their own bill and open a dialogue with the Nursing Association to see if a compromise can be reached.

Ms. Schalles- Think a dialogue needs to be opened between NAVTA and Nursing Association to help with understanding of the roles of Veterinary Nurse and the reasoning behind the change.

B. Proposed adoption of language to NAC 638: The proposed language will establish the use and requirements of telemedicine in the State of Nevada as well as amend language for the requirements veterinary applicants to sit for the Species-Specific Examinations.

Telemedicine

<u>Pelsue</u>- Cleaning up previous language, removing the term Teletriage and including it under Telehealth.

Gorman- Section 6A- The language states that this can only be initiated through an internet program or an 'app'. There are phone services available, if a veterinarian is licensed in NV, why would these services not be acceptable?

<u>Pedigo</u>- They would be licensed in Nevada, especially if they can access records.

<u>Pelsue</u>- Section 5.3, supervising veterinarian. Separate from supervisory status, telemedicine may not be used to replace indirect, direct, or immediate supervision.

<u>Ling</u>- May not be used for out-of-state veterinarian to "supervise" LVT's in the field. Language will be cleaned up to clarify.

<u>Gorman</u>- There is a fee to the hospital for the telemedicine service, subscription, but not a service to the client directly. Think it needs to be clarified to prevent problems in the future.

Species Specific Exam

<u>Ling</u>- eliminating the exam for applicants that had not taken the NAVLE in the past 5 years, except for any individuals with discipline in other states.

A. Amendment to NAC 638: The proposed amendment will eliminate the requirement for Equine Dental Providers (EDP) to obtain liability insurance to be registered in the State of Nevada as EDPs.

- SB57, the proposed changes to current statutory language, eliminating/amending current language.
- SB 224, CBD, being reworked with the language for veterinary medicine.
- Change current language for zoonotic vaccines to include LVT's an exclude "or a person under the immediate supervision of a veterinarian".
- Change "visiting" specialty/diplomate language for better protection and assign responsibility of care. Consider eliminating/convert language and requiring temporary license.

- Alter notification requirements and remove notary requirements for licenses.
- Notification of BOP, Vet Board, DEA, required when ET ceases to work for a law enforcement agency within 15 days.
- May not renew any license if outstanding fees in a disciplinary case are due to the Board.
- Hospital must disclose if they have any financial interest in another hospital the client is being referred to.
- Strike/Eliminate ability for a PE to be performed in the Vet Board office for investigative purposes.
- Remove summary suspension language in NRS that conflicts with summary suspension language in Nevada Administrative Act.
- Add new type of discipline, 'Letter of Correction', for certain administrative actions, ie.
 CE, repeat violations on Hospital Inspections... temporarily posted for a certain period, once corrected, allow to be removed from the website.
- Alter presentation of complaints not requiring the full Board to review complaints and move to a "panel" for complaints presenting final finding to the Board for vote, LOR/Consent Decree..., allowing for fair hearing process. No Open Meeting requirement with 'panel' configuration, closed door.
